## Covid -19 Home School Agreement

### Parents agreement

We understand that when sending our child to school from September 2020, Fritchley Nursery and Infant School will be following the official guidance, which recognises that *“younger children will not be able to maintain social distancing and it is acceptable for them not to distance within their group”*. Please be very clear about this. When your child returns to school in September, they will not be expected to social distance with others in the same bubble. With infant aged children especially, there is no chance of avoiding close contact and some sharing of resources. Instead, the Government strategy for returning to school relies on these essential protective measures which include:

- Minimising contact with individuals who are unwell
- Clean hands thoroughly, more often than usual
- Ensure good respiratory hygiene
- Introduced enhanced cleaning
- Minimise contact between bubbles and maintain social distancing wherever possible

### I/we will:

- Only have **1 adult** per family pick up or drop off. Observing social distancing on arrival and departure.
- Not enter school unless by a pre-arranged appointment and then only if social distancing can occur.
- Teach our child the phrase ‘Catch it, bin it, kill it’ so that it becomes a regular habit.
- Talk to our child about healthy habits i.e. hand washing, sneezing and coughing into tissues, not touching their face (mouth, eyes, nose) wherever possible. Also we will talk to them about what social distancing means and that they need to try and keep space between them and others.
- Ensure our child has washed their hands before they come to school.
- Ensure our child is wearing clean uniform each day. EYFS children to consider the types of clothes children attend in e.g. elasticated waste trousers, skirts, Velcro shoes /trainers (any clothing that does not require adult assistance/supervision).
- Only bring a reading book, a water bottle, a coat and a sunhat (and a packed lunch if required).
- Keep our child at home if they are unwell in ANY way.
- **Isolate the whole family for 14 days if a family member at home shows symptoms and your child will not come into school.**
- **Collect your child immediately if contacted by school, if they show any symptoms of COVID-19 and they will isolate for at least 7 days.**
