Here are some ideas for some home learning activities. Please try to do the red activities every day. Choose one green/yellow/purple/blue activity to do too each day, if you are able to.

<u>Daily Activities</u>	Cosmic Yoga PE lesson for 30 minutes	Encourage your child to copy some letters from their name. This could be written in flour in a tray etc.	Encourage your child to dress themselves with a little bit of help when needed.	Please practise counting or writing numbers 1-10.	Please read a story to your child
<u>Choose one green activity a day</u>	Watch Stick Man on bbc i-player (link below) OR Listen to Julia Donaldson read Stick Man (link below)	Use sticks/leaves/stones to create figures of people outside. Take photos of them to send to Mrs Shaw. Create your own Stick Man! Can you create a stick family?	The stick man floats out to sea. Experiment with floating and sinking at home. What objects float and sink? You could do this in your paddling pool if it's sunny!	Discuss the different seasons throughout the book. What happens in each season? Can you create a fingerprint picture for each season?	Collect lots of sticks. Can you create a raft with them to help a toy travel across water? (example below)
<u>Choose one yellow activity a day</u>	Use a stick to measure the length of different things in your house. (tv, sofa, table, door, radiator) record these measurements in whichever way you choose. (e.g. TV is 5 sticks long.)	Collect lots of sticks. Play Pooh Sticks with your family! Discuss which stick comes 1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd , 4 th etc. Can you order them in size order?	Practise singing the days of the week song. Every day this week, say the name of the day and get a grown up to ask you, what day was it yesterday? What day will it be tomorrow?	Have a look at the 3D Shape PowerPoint. (See link below) Can you find any 3D shaped objects in your house?	Collect sticks and leaves and count them. How many do you have?
<u>Choose one purple activity a day</u>	Help to prepare a picnic (and then eat it!)	Help to do a job in the garden	Do a job everyday that your grown up asks you to do	Help to put the washing on and hang it out to dry	Help to prepare for dinner and clean up after
<u>Choose one blue activity a day</u>	Have a look at the 'Where is Stick Man?' pictures. (See link below) Can you say some sentences to tell someone where Stick Man is?	Use the website Draw with Rob and have a go at following the instructions for drawing. http://www.robbiddulph.com/draw-with-rob	Please practise phonics for at least 10 minutes (see PhonicsPlay below)	Think of a game that can be played with a stick. Give your game a name.	Can you write/draw a postcard from the Stickman to a friend to tell them about his adventures?
